## 2. STRATEGIES FOR ATTRACTING HIGHLY SKILLED WORKERS

Amid rising demand for highly skilled talent from overseas, the

Osaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry is working hard to

attract high-level workers. A recent seminar, Strategies for Attracting Highly Skilled Workers, is just one

example of the chamber's efforts to correct the mismatch of workers and available jobs.

The seminar featured expert speakers, who used real case studies to explain issues such as why highly skilled foreign workers have become so highly sought after and where Japan's stands in the global competition for such talent, as well as strategies for attracting the right workers and management tactics for avoiding mismatches.

The broad variety of attendees-from the general corporate community as well as specialist foreign talent organizations-showed that Covid-19 has not dampened interest in acquiring highly skilled workers from overseas.

#### 3. OCCI-BACKED INITIATIVE FOR BUILDING A MEDICAL DEVICE DEVELOPMENT

#### Ecosystem Selected by AMED for Public Assistance

An OCCI-backed initiative to establish a nationwide ecosystem for the development of medical equipment has been selected by the Japan Agency for Medical Research and Development for support under its program to promote Medical-Engineering Partnerships for Innovation. The "Initiative to Promote Independence of Local Partnership Hubs in Kansai to Help Establish Japan's Premier Ecosystem for Medical Device Development" was developed by the Medical Device Industry Forum, an OCCI organization launched in 2003 to help remove the roadblocks to development of medical equipment and create new business opportunities through public-private (and private-private) partnerships.

## 4. THREE MAIN KANSAI CHAMBERS FORMULATE PROPOSAL ON PROMOTION OF LIFE SCIENCE INDUSTRY

Osaka, Kobe, Kyoto Chambers Pursue Initiatives to Further Enhance a Major Industrial Strength The Life Sciences Promotion Council, a joint organization of the Osaka, Kobe, and Kyoto chambers of commerce and industry, finalized its proposal to the government regarding promotion of the life science industry in FY2021 at a meeting on July 28. The proposal included: Ongoing support for businesses striving to maintain and improve Japan's productivity with a view to addressing healthcare security issues; and Deregulation that would remove restrictions on the ability to showcase state-of-the-art healthcare solutions at the 2025 World Expo in Osaka.

The council was established by the Osaka, Kobe, and Kyoto chambers to promote regional civilian cooperation and partnership. The council is headed by: Isao Teshirogi, vice chairman of OCCI, president and CEO of Shionogi & Co., Ltd.; Tsuneo Murata, vice-chairman of the Kyoto Chamber of Commerce and Industry, chairman of the board of Murata Manufacturing Co., Ltd.; Hisashi Ietsugu, chairman of the Kobe Chamber of Commerce and Industry, chairman and CEO of Sysmex Corporation.

The council holds regular meetings (the meeting held on July 28, 2021, being the tenth), with all three parties bringing their unique perspectives to further bolster the life science industry, one of the Kansai region's foremost strengths.

#### 5. 2025 WORLD EXPO PREP PROGRESSING, CORPORATE PARTICIPANTS WANTED

Preparations for the 2025 World Expo in Osaka are progressing apace, and the Osaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry is committed to ensuring the participation of a broad variety of businesses. To that end, the chamber is working in partnership with the Japan Association for the 2025 World Exhibition and the Osaka city and prefectural governments on a promotional campaign to spread the word far and wide. This is just one example of OCCI's various projects aimed at boosting momentum in the run-up to the expo.

On August 19, the association unveiled the various options for corporate participation in the expo, officially beginning the process of negotiating sponsorships of corporate pavilion exhibitions and themed pavilions. Calls have also gone out for business interested in participating in the Osaka pavilion, which will be operated in conjunction with the Osaka city and prefectural governments.

OCCI, together with the Kansai Economic Federation, the Kansai Association of Corporate Executives, and the Kyoto and Kobe chambers of commerce, will hold an online briefing to explain the ins and outs of corporate participation in the expo.
